The letter of motivation is one of the most important elements of your application. It should be brief and to the point. Keep in mind that your target audience is the Selection Committee – its members are accomplished academics with professional experience outside of academia. Introduce yourself, write about your academic and professional accomplishments, and explain why you believe the TRAIL+ Programme will benefit you and your career. Without exaggerating, be positive about yourself and your outlook on life. Tell us how and why you wish you to contribute to the TRAIL+ spirit and experience.

28. ACADEMIC ESSAY IN ENGLISH

In a separate document, please respond to <u>one</u> of the three questions below in a twopage (maximum 1000 words) academic essay in English. Try to structure your essay deductively and correctly reference any sources you cite. The World Trade Institute – like any graduate school – employs plagiarism detection software.

- (2) "Please describe what you consider to be some of the key challenges confronting the World Trade Organization as its members strive to conclude the Doha Development Agenda."
- (3) "How does, in your opinion, international trade benefit your country?"

29. LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

In your application to the TRAIL+ Programme, we require you to submit two letters of recommendation from two different authors.

If you are enrolled at a university or recently graduated, the letters should be written by two (former) professors or by a professor and an employer. If you completed your previous degree more than three years ago, the letters should be written by a current





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and/or former employer. The letters need to be specific to your application to the TRAIL+ Programme. You may submit them along with the other application documents in signed and sealed envelopes. 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APPENDIX I: ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

The TRAIL+ Programme is taught exclusively in English and you need to arrive at the WTI with a level of English that allows you to fully benefit from the courses. In particular, your level of English needs to allow you to express yourself effectively in and outside the classroom, deliver on weekly writing assignments and adequately cover a weekly reading load of up to 200 pages.

When evaluating your application, the Selection Committee pays close attention to evidence of your proficiency in English. As is common for graduate programmes, you are required to submit objective test scores of one of the accepted tests listed below:

Exemptions

The following applicants are exempt from submitting test scores:

- Native English speakers
- Students with an undergraduate and/or graduate degree from an institution in the USA, Canada, the UK, Ireland, Australia or New Zealand, where English was the primary language of instruction and the degree was awarded no longer than five years ago.

You may apply for exemption from submitting text scores if you are

- a student with an undergraduate and/or graduate degree from an institution where English
 was the primary language of instruction and the degree was awarded no longer than five
 years ago,
- a student who has completed at least one year of study in an English speaking country and at an institution where English was the primary language of instruction immediately prior to joining the TRAIL+ Programme.

Please <u>contact us</u> if you are unsure of your exemption status and we will be glad to help. However, please be advised that exemptions from the language requirement are rarely granted.

Important: Independent of your exemption status, you are required to fill in the section on English language in the TRAIL+ Application Form and submit a two-page essay in English as part of your application.



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APPENDIX II: REGISTRATION FEES

Upon admission to the TRAIL+ Programme, we kindly ask you transfer a one-time, non-refundable registration fee of CHF 200. You will receive the WTI's bank details along with the confirmation of admission.

Please note that you will only receive further details about the TRAIL+ once you have transferred the registration fee. We will apply the registration against your tuition fees, unless you receive a WTI Scholarship covering your entire tuition.

Please note that any charges incurred during the transfer of the registration fee must be borne by the applicant.

APPENDIX III: TUITION, SCHOLARSHIPS AND FINANCIAL AID

The tuition fee for one year of graduate studies on the TRAIL+ Programme is CHF 27'000. All TRAIL+ applicants will be considered for scholarships upon request. A limited number of scholarships and a limited amount of financial aid are available. Please consult the information on scholarships and financial aid on our website if you are in need of support.

Tuition covers all courses, the supervision of your master's thesis, a trip to Geneva with visits to international organisations as well as a range of extracurricular activities.

Tuition does not cover airfares, costs of accommodation/living, health insurance, books or any other expenditure incurred during your stay in Switzerland.
