For its first annual conference the Jean Monnet [TIISA Network](#) invites submissions relating to the measurement of services by mode of supply. In line with the networks interdisciplinary character this includes papers in the fields of law, political science, and business & economics. More specifically, this includes:

1. Advances in the measurement of trade in services data by mode of supply.
 - Structural issues with respect to data collection;
 - Methodological advances to split aggregated data by mode of supply;
 - Mapping of services trade data to other accounts.
2. Advances in the measurement of trade in services policies.
 - Harmonizing policy measures across different domains of services trade policy (GATS vs. RTAs vs. Applied Measures);
 - Options to update services schedules' sectoral classification accounting for new trends in cross-border services supply.
3. Advances in assessing the determinants of services trade and policy by mode of supply.

Note, that the day before the conference a [PhD workshop](#) is organized, where late stage PhD students are invited to present their work.
