

About the English language requirements

The TRAIL+ program is taught exclusively in English. Therefore, you need to arrive at the WTI with a level of English. In particular, the level of English needs to allow you to express yourself effectively in and outside the classroom, deliver on weekly writing assignments and adequately cover weekly readings.

You are required to submit objective test scores of one of the accepted tests listed below:

Test

Minimum Score

TOEFL iBT 100 points or above

TOEFL Paper 600 points or above

IELTS 7.0 or above

Cambridge CAE A

Cambridge CPE C or higher

Exemptions

The following applicants are exempt from submitting test scores:

A student with an undergraduate and/or graduate degree from an institution where English was the primary language of instruction, and the degree was awarded no longer than five years ago

A student who has completed at least one year of study in an English-speaking country and at an institution where English was the primary language of instruction immediately prior to joining the TRAIL+ program.

Native English speakers: Students with an undergraduate and/or graduate degree from an institution in the USA, Canada, the UK, Ireland, Australia or New Zealand, where English was the primary language of instruction, and the degree was awarded no longer than five years ago.

Important: If you believe you are exempt from submitting an English test score, please state the relevant reasons in the comment box in the online application form.
